TITLE: Baptism and the Lord's Supper

PASSAGE: Various Passages

SERIES: DNA: Who We Are, What We Do, Why It Matters

1. What is baptism?
2. What does baptism represent? (Read Romans 6:3-4)
3. Who should be baptized? Who should not be baptized? Support your answer with scripture. (Matt 28:19-20, Mark 16:15-16 and Acts 2:38 are great places to start.)
4. What is the best method of baptism? How does Romans 6:4 (specifically the word *buried*) speak to this?
5. Are you baptized? If yes, why did you decide to get baptized? Was it a difficult decision? If no, why are you waiting?
6. What is communion?
7. What do the bread and the wine represent in the Lord's supper? (Matthew 26:26-28)
8. Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-33. What is the participant supposed to remember as they take partake in the Lord's Supper? Who can partake in the Lord's Supper? What is the significance of the phrase *unworthy manner*?
9. What is the significance of the Lord's supper happening at the last Passover meal? (Hint: research the Passover by reading Exodus 12.)
10. Read Matthew 26:29 and Revelation 19:6-10. Is the Lord's Supper a foretaste of the Marriage Supper of the Lamb? Why or why not? Discuss.
