5. Read Revelation 11:12, 2 Kings 2:11-12, Acts 1:6-11. What do you learn about the ascension to heaven in these passages?
6. What would be your reaction if you saw any one of these scenes where they are taken up to heaven?
7. God will use all things to glorify himself. Do you believe this? Is there an area in your life where you find this hard to be true?
8. Towards the end of the sermon, we were encouraged to remain faithful to God. What is God asking you to do? Are you being faithful to what God is asking you to do as:
  - a. A husband/wife
  - b. A parent
  - c. A caregiver
  - d. A student
  - e. An employee
  - f. A friend

**PRAYER POINTS** (based on Revelation 11:1-14):

**THE PRAISEWORTHY QUALITIES OF GOD THE FATHER AND GOD THE SON:**

- God alone has resurrection power (v11)
- God is worthy of all glory (v13)
