**TITLE:** Look & See

**PASSAGE:** Revelation 15:1-8

**SERIES:** The Book of Revelation: Worthy is the Lamb

**BIG IDEA:** Behold God's greatness and his glory as he carries out his plans.

**I. Look and see the plan of God: Trust Him (v1)**

**II. Look and see the greatness of God: Worship Him (v2-4)**

*"holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God almighty who was and is to come" Rev 4:8*

*"Worthy are you, our Lord and God to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created." Rev 4:11*

*Thus, it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, <sup>47</sup> and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. Luke 24:47*

*<sup>9</sup> Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Phil 2:9-11*

**III. Look and see the glory of God: Be in Awe of Him (v5-8)**

**TITLE:** Look & See

**SERIES:** The Book of Revelation: Worthy is the Lamb

**PASSAGE:** Revelation 15:1-8

**BIG IDEA:** Behold God's greatness and his glory as he carries out his plans.

**DISCUSSION:**

**I. Look and see the plan of God: Trust Him (v1)**

1. Are you currently in a situation where you are questioning God's plans and if he is fulfilling his plan? What are the details of your struggle?
2. If you are not currently in a struggle like this, recall and record a time in your life that you were questioning God and his plans.
3. How do you feel about God fulfilling his plans in Revelation 15:1.

**II. Look and see the greatness of God: Worship Him (v2-4)**

4. Read Revelation Chapter 4 and Revelation 15:2-4. What similarities do you see between these two texts? What differences do you see between these two texts?
5. Revelation 15:3. "*Great and Amazing are your deeds, O Lord God the Almighty.*" What are some of God's great and amazing deeds that are recorded in Scripture? What are some of these great and amazing deeds that he has done in your own life?
6. Read Revelation 15:3-4, compare it to the Song of Moses in Deuteronomy 32:1-43 and The Song of Moses in Exodus 15:1-18. What similarities do you observe?

### **III. Look and see the glory of God: Be in Awe of Him (v5-8)**

7. Read Rev. 15:8, Ex. 40:34; Isa. 6:4; Hag. 2:7. What do you observe in these texts?
  
8. The good news for believers is that God's wrath will be finished with these coming bowl judgements which means Jesus will be returning soon. The bad news for unbelievers is that salvation will no longer be available to them once God's wrath is finished.
  - a. How do you feel about that statement?
  
  - b. How can this truth lead you to more evangelistic outreach?
  
  - c. Who can you pray for and share the gospel with this week?
