**DATE:** November 13, 2022

**TITLE:** The Second Coming of Jesus Christ

**SERIES:** The Book of Revelation: Worthy is the Lamb

**PASSAGE:** Revelation 19:11-21

**DISCUSSION:**

Jesus Christ is coming again. Hallelujah! Read Revelation 19:11-21.

1. Point one from the sermon is “Behold the glory of Jesus Christ” (v11-16).
  - a. How is Jesus described in verses 11-16?
  - b. Which of these are you the most excited about?
  - c. Which of these are you the most fearful about?
2. What are the names of Jesus in this section?
  - a. What does it mean to you that he is Faithful and True?
  - b. What significance is it that he is called the “The Word of God”? Is he called this elsewhere in the Bible?
  - c. What does it mean for Jesus to be the “King of kings and Lord of lords”?
3. Read Revelation 19:15, Isaiah 11:1-5, 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12, and Hebrews 4:11-13. What do you observe about the words that Jesus speaks?
4. Verse 12 says Jesus’ “eyes are like a flame of fire,” indicating that nothing escapes his notice. When Jesus looks at your life, what might be one struggle Jesus wants you to surrender to him?
5. Point two from the sermon is “Behold the victory of Jesus” (v17-21).
  - a. What is Jesus victorious over?
  - b. What situation or struggle are you currently in that you need to be reminded of this truth?
6. This passage emphasizes at least four different names of Jesus, one of which is known only to him (v12). What are some other names and/or titles of Jesus from the Bible that give you comfort? (Consider passages like Isaiah 9:6 or the “I am” statements in the gospel of John to get started.)
7. We cannot defeat the enemy on our own, only Jesus can. So, what is it in your life that you need Jesus to do?
  - a. Fix a relationship? – He can do that!
  - b. Give you direction? – He can do that!
  - c. Overcome a problem? – He can do that!
  - d. Break a bad habit? – He can do that!
  - e. Make a tough decision? – He can do that!
  - f. Ask someone to forgive you? – He can do that!
  - g. Something else? What is it?

Spend some time in prayer and accountability reaching out to Jesus asking him to do what only he can in these struggles of yours.

**PRAYER POINTS** (based on Revelation 19:11-21):

**THE PRAISEWORTHY QUALITIES OF GOD THE FATHER AND GOD THE SON:**

- Jesus is victorious (i.e., riding on the white horse; v11, 15)
- Jesus is Faithful and True, and the righteous Judge (v11)
- Jesus is our warrior (v11)
- Jesus alone can see beneath the surface of our lives (v12)
- Jesus has all authority (v12)
- Jesus is worthy and majestic (v12)
- Jesus is known by us but still mysterious (v12)
- Jesus wears the blood of sacrifice on his robe (v13)
- Jesus is The Word of God – the revelation of God to us (v13)
- Jesus leads the armies of heaven into the final battle (v14)
- Jesus is King of kings and Lord of lords (v16)
- Jesus executes perfect justice and judgement against his enemies (v20-21)
