SMALL GROUPS Curriculum

DATE: November 20, 2022 **TITLE**: Life in the Millennium

SERIES: The Book of Revelation: Worthy is the Lamb

PASSAGE: Revelation 20:1-6

DISCUSSION:

1. Have you heard teaching on the millennium before? What did you know or think about this time period prior to hearing the sermon?

Responsible scholars disagree on the meaning of 1000 years, and they fall into three categories: premillennialists, postmillennialists, and amillennialists. All three of these positions fall within the framework of historic Christian orthodoxy. Instead of arguing over positions and personal opinions, our focus is on *life in the millennium*.

- 2. What do the various names for the dragon represent (v2)? Where is the dragon sent and for how long (v3)? What "must" happen at the end of that time (v3)? What does the absence of Satan mean for the millennium?
- 3. God continues to give people born during the millennium the opportunity to believe in Him, yet some choose disobedience despite the absence of Satan's influence. What does this teach us about human nature? What Bible verses can you think of that elaborate on how deep-seated our sinful nature is?
- 4. Considering what you learned about human nature, how effective is the argument, "the devil made me do it" as a defence for sin?
- 5. Compare and contrast God's actions toward the faithful with his actions against Satan. What aspects of His character does it reveal?
- 6. How does your growing knowledge of the millennium and end times give you a greater appreciation for God? What is one lesson that you've learned in this series that has impacted your life?
- 7. How might you take your faith more seriously when you reflect on the judgment coming to Satan, the judgement on those who reject God, and the blessings that await those who repent and believe in Jesus? What are you going to do about it?
