# **SMALL GROUPS** Curriculum

DATE: December 4, 2022

TITLE: His Name Shall Be: Wonderful Counsellor

**SERIES:** His Name Shall Be

**PASSAGE:** Isaiah 9:6 (and other passages)

### **DISCUSSION:**

- 1. "Wonderful" means unique, extraordinarily great, surprisingly excellent, causing to marvel. When have you received a wonderful gift that fits that definition?
- 2. "For to us a child is born" speaks to the humanity of Jesus. Where else in Scripture do we read of the humanity of Jesus? Why is it important that Jesus is fully human?
- 3. "To us a son is given" speaks to the divinity of Jesus. Where else in Scripture do we read of the divinity of Jesus? Why is it important that Jesus is fully divine?
- 4. Look up Colossians 2:2b-3. What is the source of wisdom and knowledge? What does that mean for our day-to-day struggles in life?
- 5. How does culture encourage people to seek wisdom apart from Jesus? What are the subtle and not-so-subtle ways we are encouraged to define our own "truth"?
- 6. The world's counsel says to *follow your heart*. What do Proverbs 4:23, Proverbs 27:19, Jeremiah 17:9, and Matthew 12:34 say about our hearts? Considering those verses, why is it dangerous advice to follow our hearts?
- 7. What do the following verses tell us about truth, and how does biblical truth differ from worldly truth? See John 8:31-32, John 14:17, John 16:13-14.
- 8. Where are you tempted to follow your heart rather than follow the wonderful wisdom of Christ? What does the Wonderful Counsellor have to say to you regarding this circumstance?

## **PRAYER POINTS** (based on this message):

#### THE PRAISEWORTHY QUALITIES OF GOD THE FATHER AND GOD THE SON:

- Jesus is our Wonderful Counsellor (Isaiah 9:6)
- Jesus knows human nature perfectly (John 2:24)
- Jesus knows everything in our hearts and still loves us! (John 2:24-25)
- God is the Source of all wisdom and invites us to pursue it (Proverbs 4:7)
- Jesus alone has the truth (and is the Truth) that will set us free (John 8:31-32)
- The Holy Spirit guides us into all truth (John 16:13-14)
