BIG IDEA: Jesus died as our propitiation. **3 ASPECTS OF GOD'S LOVE FOR US:** 1. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ of love: God sent his only Son (v9) 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of love: To be the propitiation for our sins (v10) PROPITIATION IS NOT: a. Jesus getting his angry Father to \_\_\_\_\_\_ about us;

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## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Have you ever heard the word propitiation? Before Sunday's message, how would you have defined that word? What are some of the ways people misunderstand the word propitiation?
- 2. Read 1 John 4:10. Define propitiation.
- 3. Read 1 John 4:9-11 and write down all the things you learn about God and what He has done.
- 4. Using only verses 9-11, define love.
- 5. 1 John 4:9 tells us how God's love was made manifest. What does manifest mean in this context?
- 6. According to this passage, why did God send His Son into the world and why was that necessary? Use correlating Scripture verses to support your answer.
- 7. The concept **God is love** is well known. What are the problems with the way culture presents this truth today?
- 8. How does God show His love for his children (v9-10)? What are we called to do as a result (v11)?
- 9. What sorts of things make you feel loved by someone?
- 10. How do you show others you love them?
- 11. Who are the people in your life that you have a hard time loving?
- 12. Read Romans 5:8. Considering how God the Father and God the Son have loved you (while you were still sinning!), how can you love this person/these people? What specific changes can you make in how you think about them, interact with them, and pray for them?
