DATE: Sunday, May 14, 2023 **TITLE**: The Call to Discipleship

SERIES: Single Sermon | All In Sunday

PASSAGE: Mark 1:16-20

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. We exist to glorify God through the fulfillment of the Great Commission in the spirit of the Great Commandment (Matthew 28:18-20; Matthew 22:37-39). What is the Great Commission?
- 2. Specifically, what two things has Jesus commanded in the Great Commission? In what two ways are we to accomplish the task (Matthew 28:18-20)?
- 3. What is the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:37-39)? The Great Commandment is simple but difficult to live out. What makes it difficult for you to love God and others the way we are commanded?

Read Mark 1:16-20

- 4. What did Simon and Andrew and James and John have to leave behind in order to follow Jesus?
- 5. Has God ever asked you to lay aside someone or something you love in order to follow Him? What was it? Was it a difficult decision?
- 6. Did the men hesitate to follow Jesus? What causes you to hesitate to follow Jesus? Why is following Jesus wholeheartedly difficult?
- 7. The call to discipleship was personal for Simon and Andrew and James and John (Mark 1:16, 19). What was different about Jesus' invitation to these men from his general invitation to all people to follow Him?
- 8. How is your invitation from Jesus both personal and general?
- 9. What did Jesus ask Simon and Andrew to do (17a)? How was Jesus going to change their focus of their work (v17b)?

- 10. How has Jesus shifted your focus since you decided to follow him?
- 11. Jesus uses the same word twice in verse 18 and 20. What does that repeated word convey about the call to discipleship? Why does it matter that we understand it?

- B) What is Jesus calling you to do next?
- C) Will you follow him?
